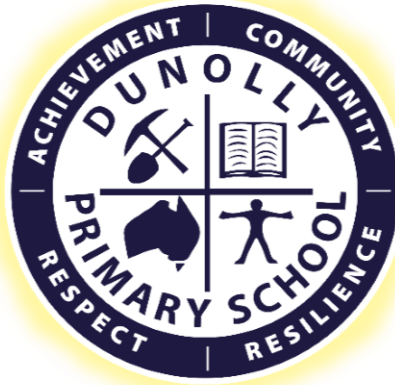

Emergency Drills

At our school, the safety and wellbeing of all students, staff and visitors is our highest priority. As part of our emergency management procedures, we practise emergency drills throughout the year to ensure everyone knows what to do in the event of an emergency.

Next week, students and staff will participate in a lockdown drill. A lockdown drill is practised when there may be a situation outside or within the school grounds that requires students and staff to remain safely inside classrooms or buildings until an "all clear" is given.

During the drill:

- Staff will guide students through the procedures in a calm and supportive manner.
- Classroom doors will be locked and students will remain quietly inside.
- The drill will be age-appropriate and explained to students beforehand.
- The process is designed to help students feel prepared and safe.

We understand that some students may feel worried or unsettled by emergency drills. Staff will provide reassurance and support throughout the process. If you believe your child may require additional support, please contact the school.
