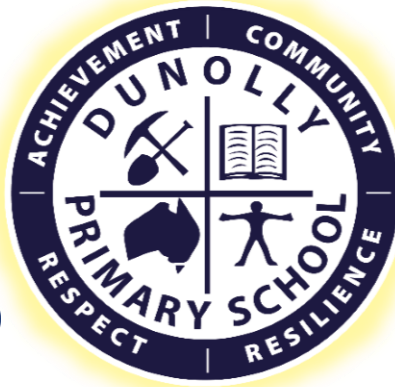

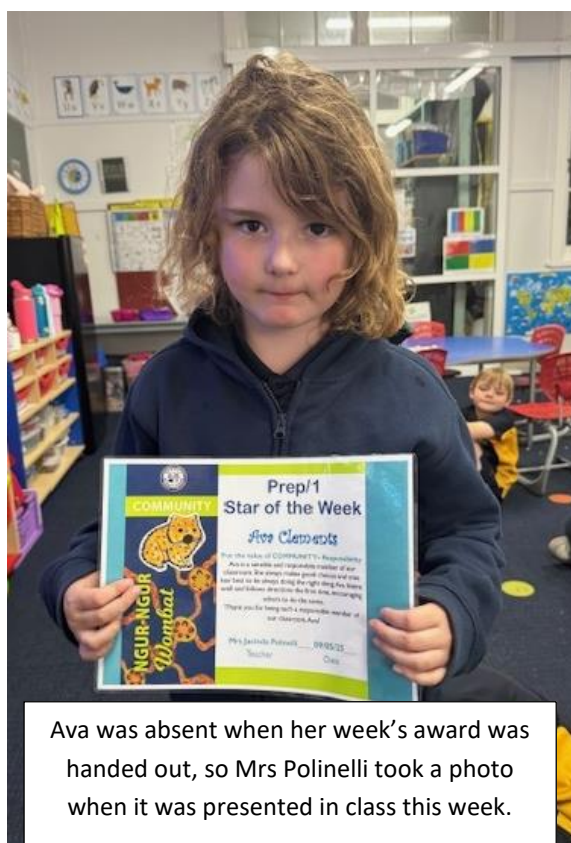

Families come along to learn about all that is involved with starting school and the transition process.

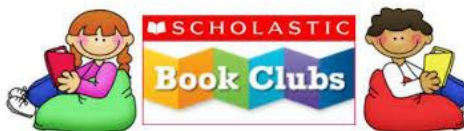

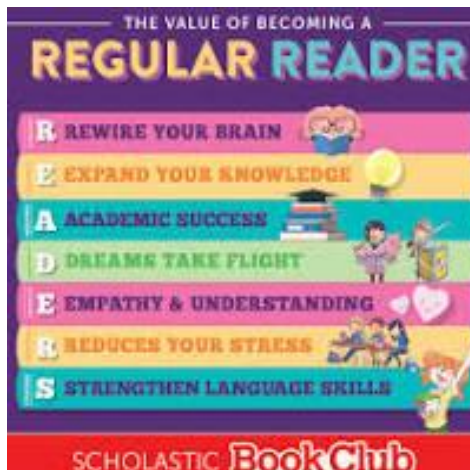
