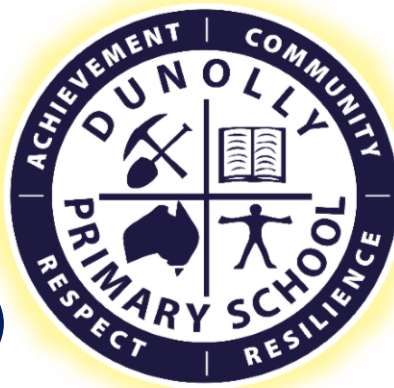

2024 Parent / Caregiver / Guardian Opinion Survey

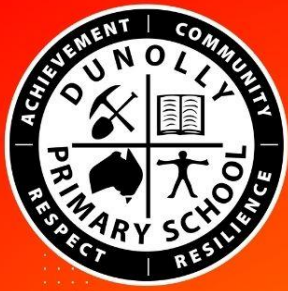

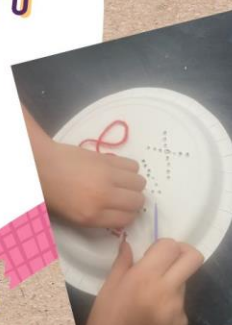
